

2019-20 Checklist for District Grant Scholarship

to be completed by the scholarship applicant with assistance of Club Counselor **Application Components**:

Club Endorsement Form from the sponsor Rotary Club
Rotary District Scholarship Application – all sections included
High School and/or College Transcript
Proof of acceptance to an undergraduate-level college/university program as a full-time student (12 units or more).
Two letters of recommendation
A budget to manage grant funds with proposed expenses for scholarship year, such as accommodations, room and board, books, tuition, fees, and other required study-related items.

During the scholarship year 2019-20:

Attend an orientation seminar, conducted at the Club or District level (August 1-15)
Submit proof of registration to an undergraduate-level program as a full-time student
(12 units or more).
Participate in Rotary meetings, activities, projects
Create a blog or social media account and append the blog to both your Mid-Term and
Final Reports as a means to share your experiences during the course of study,
Participate in Rotary meetings, community service projects, and fundraising events at a
Rotary club near the college/university.
Obtain mid-Term (before December 15) and Final (before March 31) unofficial
transcripts (must show full-time enrollment) and forward them to your club counselor
and the D5190 Scholarship Chair (see e-address below). Mid-Term Report required
before club releases second half of scholarship funds.
Submit required Mid-Term Report (before December 15) and Final (before March 31)
Report and Budget with full accounting of funds with receipts for items costing \$75 or
more to your club counselor and the D5190 Scholarship Chair (see e-address below).

Scholar will be required to submit periodic reports to the Sponsor Club counselor and to the District Scholarship Chair David Crumbley: crumbley5190@gmail.com

Scholar is required to submit **receipts for items in excess of \$75.00** to support the expenses.
