MARK OF EXCELLENCE

- Comes in four colors:
 - yellow, blue, black and white
- Should be used in large format
- Must have lettering inside the wheel



Our Logos







MASTERBRAND

- Comes in several colors & combinations
- Can be used in any size
- Can have traditional or simplified wheel
- Can be customized for your club, district, etc.






Use in larger formats so we can read the lettering inside the wheel



Public Image Checklist

Your Web Site

- Make sure your web site speaks to non-Rotarians
- Limit parts of web site that will expire often
- Be sure people know how to contact you if they are interested in joining
- Check monthly at a minimum



Public Image Checklist Your Social Media

- At least be on Facebook, consider Instagram too
 - Cross-posting makes it easy!
- Post regularly (2-3 times per week)
- Follow social media rule of thirds
- Get members to like AND SHARE
- Tag your partners
- Remember branding



The Rule of Thirds

• Fun

- Cartoons, fun photos, recaps of club events with photos
- Consider playing on existing social themes like #tbt or #fbf

Informative

- Information about Rotary, our mission, our values, etc.
- Community news

Promotional

- Invitations to join or visit a meeting
- Promoting fundraisers and events




Liking, Sharing & Tagging

 - Respond "going" to events (even if they aren't!)
 - Like, share and comment
 - Share into Facebook groups
- Tag the pages of other organizations, businesses or partners whenever it makes sense so you can reach their followers too
 - First like their pages as your page

- To be done by an admin or editor of your club's page
- Go to the page of the organization or partner you want to connect with
- Click the button with the three little dots to open the drop down menu shown here
- Choose "Like as your Page" and a
 menu will appear to select which page you want to like this page
- This will make it easier to tag this page in your posts


Tagging Others in Your Post

 Use the @ symbol to prompt Facebook to pull up pages and people to tag

Start typing the name (no spaces) and it should come up in the menu that appears

Be sure to select the right one

 You will then see the page name appear in your post in blue because it is tagged
