Dear Fellow Rotarians of District 6420:

As you may know, our District is governed by a set of By-Laws that are periodically reviewed, updated, and revised. Every four years, our District participates in the selection process to select a member of the Rotary International Board of Directors. Presently, our By-Laws do not provide for selection of our delegate, or representative, on that multi-district (Zone) nominating committee.

It has been proposed that the district's By-Laws be amended to provide for that procedure, utilizing our District Nominating Committee that is also responsible for screening and selecting the District Governor annually, and Representative on Rotary's Council on Legislation triennially.

While in the process of updating the By-Laws, it is also suggested that minor non-substantive corrections be made. This includes the reorganization of the Articles in a more logical sequence, and to add a table of contents for ease of reference.

These amendments are proposed by the Putnam County Rotary Club, for consideration at the next District Training Assembly which will be held, hopefully in person, on March 19, 2022. Each Club having at least one member at the DTA is entitled to one vote. Passage requires 2/3 approval. The same process will apply if we go "virtual" for this year's DTA.

Attached please find a copy of the By-Laws with the proposed changes noted.

If you or your Club has any questions about the Amendment or process, please let me know. Otherwise, no action need be taken until we convene for our District Training Assembly on March 19.

Thank you for your consideration of the proposed amendments.
