WAYS CLUBS CAN GET INVOLVED

Mentorship & Career Exposure:

- Host career panels or job shadow days

- Set up informal mentor chats or “Ask Me Anything” events

Confidence & Leadership Skills:

- Offer public speaking or personal branding workshops
- Organize a Confidence Bootcamp or Leadership Day
- Host time management or goal-setting sessions
- Launch a student recognition or ambassador program

Workplace Readiness:

- Host resume help or financial literacy nights
- Support students in learning interview and professional etiquette

Club-Led Signature Events:

- Organize a ‘Level Up Summit’ with local leaders
- Launch a student recognition or ambassador program

Partnerships & Ongoing Engagement:

- Partner with schools, Interact, or RYLA alumni
- Invite students to club meetings or service projects
- Pair students with Rotarian mentors for monthly check-ins
