District 5180 Hall of Fame

Criteria and Procedure

<u>Eligibility</u>

- a. Must have served 20 years or more in Rotary
- b. Must have served 10 years or more in District 5180

Procedure

- a. Clubs may put forward members of their club to be considered through an application process
- A committee of no more than 5 Hall of Fame members will screen the candidates, reviewing the information received to make sure that all pertinent information is part of the application
- c. This select committee can also put forward other deserving candidates who meet the criteria.
- d. All candidates and their pertinent information, that are considered potential candidates for the Hall of Fame, will be sent to all living Hall of Fame members.
- e. Hall of Fame members will vote for those they feel are deserving of being part of the Hall of Fame
- f. A candidate must receive at least 75% affirmative votes from those Hall of Fame members voting and no more than 5 (with the highest percentage total) will be inducted in any one year. Those that receive 75% and not inducted will automatically be considered in the future years
