PROJECT DESCRIPTION; Biosand Water Filters - BSF

Provide 340 BSF at \$ 100 each = \$ 34,000, includes aprox \$ 500 for a steel mold to build filters at beneficiaries' communities, teaching hygienic norms and filters maintenance training.

PROJECT SITE: East Cone of Metropolitan Lima, PERU.

BENEFICIARIES

3,400 people who currently live in a single room made out of bricks, triply and cardboard. Communities are located on the hillside of mountains, near the highly contaminated RIMAC RIVER, families that lack potable water and sanitation, mostly under 5 year old children, who constantly suffer from diarrheas and intestinal parasites. **AREA OF FOCUS:** Water and Sanitation.
