Our Project Objectives:

- To build sanitary toilets with handwashing sinks in schools and homes in poor areas.
- To provide awareness of the benefits of safe water, sanitation, and hygiene (handwashing.)
- To build toilets to reduce diseases from open sewage contaminated by human excreta.
- To improve attendance and retention of young girls in the school in poor areas.

Home Toilets cost \$250 each.

School Block Toilets \$6,500 each.

- 1. Coordinate and Finance Projects Remotely
 - A. Replacing **Desktops** in schools (~\$500 USD)
 - B. Floor in La Caridad (~\$7,500 USD remaining balance needed)
- 2. Gather Supplies for Service Trip 2022
 - A. Eyeglasses (all readers', old prescription glasses, lens cleaners)
 - B. Dental Supplies (toothbrushes, toothpaste, floss)
 - C. Children's Toys (window stickers, easy read Spanish books, coloring books think small/lightweight items that Team Members can easily transport through Customs)
- 3. Projects Needing Monetary Assistance
 - A. Feed a Village (~\$350 USD)
 - B. Donate to buy medical/dental supplies (~\$500 USD)
