#### DISTRICT DUES WILL BE INCREASING

- \$10 increase
- \$60 / Member
  - Effective July 1, 2024
  - Last increase was 2008-9 16 years ago
  - 42% inflation factor

The Rotary Foundation (TRF) was started after 1917 Atlanta **Convention Surplus of \$26.50** By Arch Klumph, **RI President for the purpose of** "Doing Good in the World"





## The Rotary Foundation Today

- Over \$5.7 Billion inception to date
- 91% of funds spent of program awards and operations
- 4 Star rating from Charity Navigator (Highest level possible) 14 Straight Years
- Funded by contributions to:
  - Annual Fund-Share\*
  - Endowment\*\*
  - PolioPlus
  - Disaster Response Funds

\* Donations to the Annual Fund-Share return to the clubs after 3 years as District Designated Funds (DDF)


\*\* Earnings from Endowment donations return to the clubs after 3 years as District Designated Funds (DDF)
