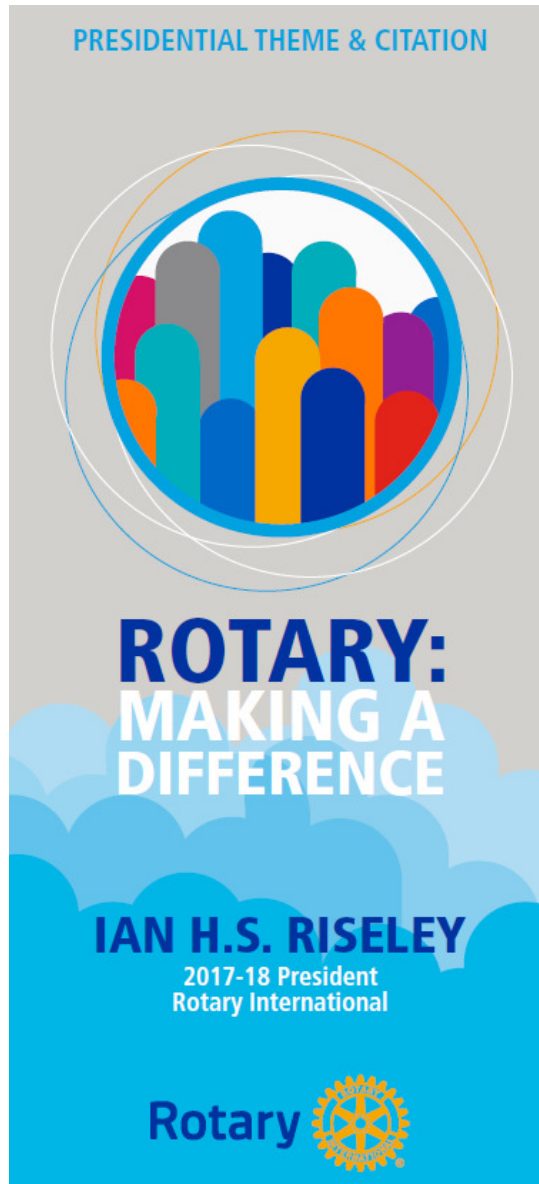
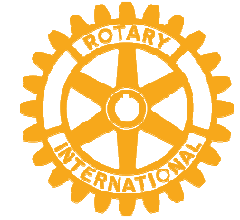
# Presidential Goals

- End Polio contributions increased
- The Rotary Foundation
  - Recommend club Annual giving at \$125.00 per member
  - Increase member participation in EREY (Centurion) to at least 30% of all members
  - Continue District Grants scheme
- Clubs encouraged to meet RIPE Ian Riseley's request for each member to plant a tree between 1 July and Tree Planting day 22 April 2018.
