Presented by the Rotary Club of Onehunga to the Club recording the best accumulated attendance percentage at Club meetings over the period July 1 to the end of the month prior to the District Conference.

➤ **THE 4-WAY TEST AWARD (discontinued 2013/14)**

Presented by Tom McKay for the club with the most effective programme promoting the Four Way Test

➤ **THE SILVER JUBILEE TROPHY (discontinued 2013/14)**

Presented by the Avondale/New Lynn Rotary Clubs. Awarded to the Club that makes the greatest contribution towards Rotary Awareness.

➤ **PRESERVE PLANET EARTH AWARD (discontinued 2013/14)**

Presented by PDG Tony and Maïté Hornabrook for recognising the Club project that best typifies Rotary's recognition of the need to preserve earth's resources.

➤ **FRIENDSHIP AWARD (discontinued 2013/14)**

Presented each year at the conclusion of Conference, by the current holder, to the Club, which in their opinion most expresses the ideals of friendship at that Conference, host clubs excluded

➤ **CONFERENCE ATTENDANCE AWARD (discontinued 2013/14)**

Presented by the Rotary Club of Mt. Roskill to the Club with the best attendance at District Conference according to the formula prescribed
