Ensure each club has a pro-active and up-to-date online presence and be sure to tell compelling stories about how your club is making a difference in your community. 5. District Public Image Team provides current material to and works with clubs to ensure all Rotary assets and materials reflect correct Rotary branding. 6. Successfully complete existing Global Grant Projects. 5. Encourage all clubs & satellites to actively support TRF with both personal and club contributions. 6. Encourage all clubs & satellites to actively support the Polio Eradication program. 7. Encourage all clubs to be part of events that raise awareness on World Polio Day.
