Rotaract dues invoice will be posted to the club finances section of the club profile in My Rotary. In addition, if the club has reported them, an email notification will be sent to the following email addresses: club president, secretary, treasurer, and club business.

Rotaract clubs will be terminated for non-payment of dues if they have a US\$75 outstanding balance after 120 days. Clubs will be notified upon termination. Clubs have 150 days to pay all outstanding dues and submit the required reinstatement documentation and fees.
