Interact Awards:

1. Interact Inspirational Award:

This award recognizes one outstanding Interactor within the District who was inspired to demonstrate outstanding achievement in Rotary and in the community both locally and internationally and through his or her actions has been an inspiration to others to do the same.

2. Leadership Award:

This award recognizes an Interactor who has volunteered time toward improving and enriching the community and/or leadership initiatives that have positively affected the quality of life of others.

3. Outstanding Interact Award:

This award is for Clubs which best reflect the themes of Interact and the District.



4. Social Award:

This award is for keeping members connected which is key to maintaining a healthy, energized club; by working together we can continue to succeed in the district.

5. Outstanding Porject award:

Recognizes Interactors who are making a sustainable impact in one of Rotary's areas of focus through their innovative community or international service projects

6. Leadership Excellence withDistinction:

This award is for keeping the Interact Club connected with Rotarians, Rotaractors, Interactors, and the District continuously throughout the year

Rotaract Awards:

- District Outstanding Clubs Award: This award is for the large, medium and small Clubs which best reflect the themes of Rotaract and the District
- 2. **District Socials Award:** This award is for keeping members connected which is key to maintaining a healthy, energized club; by working together we can continue to succeed in the district.
- 3. **District Outstanding Project Award:** Recognizes Rotaractors who are making a sustainable impact in one of Rotary's areas of focus through their innovative community or international service projects.



District Rotary Awards:

1. Norm Simpson Award for International Service -

This trophy is awarded annually to the club(s) in the district that made the most outstanding contribution to the International Service of Rotary during the preceding Rotary year.

- 2. Les Faludy Leadership Award- Awarded to a Club Presidents who, in the judgement of the District Governor Team, provided the most outstanding leadership during the Rotary year.
- 3. **Tibor Gregor Community Service Award -** This award is given to the club with the best Community Service project during the year.
- 4. **Council of Past District Governors Award-** This is awarded annually to the Rotarian(s) who had made the greatest service contribution during the year.
- 5. **Club Bulletin Award-** Clubs that excel in broadcasting the weekly meeting results to their members make a positive difference.
- 6. Oddy Robson Memorial Award Presented to the club that contributes most to inter-club fellowship.
- 7. **Basil Tippet Award -** Awarded to the club(s) with the highest member retention ratio based on clubs' membership at the beginning of the Rotary year.
- 8. Wally Large Memorial Award Awarded to the club with the highest % increase of membership growth in year.
- Youth Services Award- This award recognizes a club that has provided outstanding service to youth over an extended period.
- 10. **External Public Relations Award -**This award honours clubs that have generated increased awareness and understanding of Rotary through social media coverage and other public relations efforts.
- 11. **DEI Award -** awarded to the Club(s) or Rotarian(s) who made the greatest contribution to the advancement of diversity, equity and inclusion.



- 12. Internal Communications Award This award covers communication within or between clubs and is open to all clubs by application. The application should include web site, club bulletins, coverage in Rotary News or samples of Rotary education campaigns.
- 13. **The Rotary Foundation Trophy Certificate –** This is awarded to the three clubs that have the highest per capita contribution to The Rotary Foundation Programs for the year. Each in one of the following three categories: clubs with less than 25 members, clubs with 25-30 members, and clubs with more than 50 members.
- 14. **The Devon & Linda Biddle Annual Fund Certificate** This award is given to the three clubs that have the highest per capita contribution to The Rotary Foundation Annual Fund Program for the year. Each in one of the following three categories: clubs with less than 25 members, clubs with 25-50 members, and clubs with more than 50 members.
- 15. **The Bill & Delphine Patchett Polio Plus Certificate –** Given to the three clubs that have the highest per capita contribution to The Rotary Foundation Polio Plus Fund Program. Each in one of the following three categories: clubs with less than 25 members, clubs with 25-30 members, and clubs with more than 50 members.
- 16. **The Ed Storie District Conference Award** This is awarded to the three clubs that have the highest per capita contribution to The Rotary Foundation Programs for the year. Each in one of the following three categories: clubs with less than 25 members, clubs with 25-30 members, and clubs with more than 50 members.
- 17. **Environmental Action Award** awarded to the Club(s) who made the greatest contribution to the area of environmental awareness, sustainability and protection.
