O.E.F. 98B

Reduction of Coverage for Lessees or Drivers of Leased Vehicles Endorsement



(for attachment only to the Standard Non-Owned Automobile Policy S.P.F. No. 6)

1. Purpose of this endorsement:

This endorsement alters the coverage provided by this policy with respect to claims in Ontario for loss or damage arising directly or indirectly from the use or operation of a motor vehicle that is leased.

2. How the policy coverage is changed:

- The Insurer also agrees to pay on behalf of every partner, officer or employee of the Insured who, in the
 business of the Insured stated in Item 3 of the application, leases an automobile for a period of not
 more than 30 days in their own name, all sums which such partner, officer or employee is legally
 obligated to pay as a result of liability imposed by law arising from the negligence of the driver of such
 leased automobile(s).
- The insurance provided under this policy with respect to leased automobiles is in excess of the underlying coverage available to the Insured or to the partner, officer or employee of the Insured.
- Underlying coverage available to the Insured or to the partner, officer or employee of the Insured includes
 any motor vehicle liability insurance that is required to respond to the liability of the driver or lessee of the
 leased automobile.

The terms leased, lease and lessee are used as equivalent to rented, rent and renter.

Except as otherwise provided in this endorsement, all limits, terms, conditions, provisions, definitions and exclusions of the policy shall have full force and effect.
