Information for Schools

1 AIMS

The aims of the contest are to:

- i promote the values of Rotary that emphasize ethics and values in life
- ii develop the confidence and self-esteem in Year 10 students.
- iii develop relationships between Rotary and primary schools.
- iv support the English curriculum (STEM) with speaking and listening opportunities
- v provide an opportunity for students to test their skills before an audience.

2 ELIGIBLE

Students who are in **Year 10** in 2022 are eligible to enter. A Rotary club must sponsor the school. Rotary clubs are encouraged to sponsor their linked secondary school.

3 CONTEST SCHEDULE

Club heats should be conducted during Term 3, Week 2 25-29 July 2022. Finals will follow during the week 8-12 August. The District Final is scheduled for the week 22-26 August. The State Final is scheduled for Thursday 8 September.

4 TOPIC

Each participant may choose their own topic, but **all four (4)** of the values of the *Rotary Four Way Test* must be woven into the speech.

- 1 Is it the TRUTH?
- 2 Is it FAIR to all concerned?
- 3 Will it build GOODWILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?
- 4 Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?

5 SPEECH LENGTH

The duration of the speech should be six (6) minutes.

A warning bell will sound at five (5) minutes with a final bell at six (6) minutes.

Penalties will apply if time varies by more than 20 second either side of six (6) minutes.

A Timekeeper will complete a time sheet, and this will be provided to the Adjudicators to assist in their final assessment.



School level: At the discretion of the school.

Club heats: One Adjudicator accredited with Rostrum or Toastmasters and at

least one Rotarian who is familiar with the Rotary judging process.

Semi-finals/Final: All Adjudicators will be accredited with Rostrum or Toastmasters plus a clear

understanding of, and experience in, Rotary-style adjudication.



ASSESSMENT

Assessment is made on the following basis:

- Inclusion and expansion of the four values of the Rotary Four Way Test woven into the
- It is important to demonstrate how Rotary values affect and influence us, and the speaker, in everyday life.
- Students offer a considered and balanced review of their topic.
- Points presented clearly and supported by appropriate evidence.
- Appeal to the audience.

Please note:

- Palm cards are permitted but their use should not detract from the overall presentation.
- No other props are permitted.
- A stand-alone microphone must be provided for club heats, semi-finals and the final.

PRIZES

School heat - winner/s:

Proceed to the Rotary club heat plus any recognition considered appropriate by the school.

Club heat - winner:

A certificate and gift voucher to the value of \$50 provided by the sponsoring Rotary Club.



A certificate and \$150 gift voucher. The winner will progress to the District Final.



A certificate and \$100 gift voucher

District Semi Final - winner:

The runner up may progress to the District Final



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# District Final - winner:

A certificate, \$250 gift voucher and the Fred Marsh Perpetual Trophy that is kept in the school for the following 12 months. The winner will progress to the State Final

# District Final - runner up:

A certificate and \$150 gift voucher. The runner up may progress to the District Final



# State Final - winner:

A certificate, \$400 gift voucher and the Fred Marsh Perpetual Trophy that is kept in the school for the following 12 months.

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# State Final - runner up:

A certificate and \$200 gift voucher.
