

HOW TO USE YOUR "MY ROTARY" ACCOUNT TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE ROTARY FOUNDATION Every Rotarian needs to register for their "My Rotary" account. It's easy. Go to <a href="https://www.rotary.org">www.rotary.org</a> and click "My Rotary." Click "Register for an Account" and enter the information requested. Rotary will send you a confirmation email. Click on that link, establish your password, and you're in!

Once registered, log in and use the "Give" button to contribute. All of your gifts are credited to your personal Paul Harris Fellowship account, your club, and District 5730. Set up a periodic donation through your credit card. If you give \$8.34 monthly you'll be a Sustaining Member and help your club attain Every Rotarian Every Year (EREY) status. For \$83.34 per month you can join the Paul Harris Society.
