Governor 1970-1971

Woody moved to Sweetwater in 1956 and was a partner in the Coker Gasoline Company. He sold the gasoline plant in 1968 and became involved with Ludlum Measurements, a manufacturer of radiation detection devices and served as district 573 14th governor. Woody was active in many civic endeavors in Sweetwater, serving as president of the school board, the PTA, the United Fund, and the Chamber of Commerce. He was Western District Chairman of the Chilsolm Trail Council, Boy Scouts of America and was

active in his church, serving in many capacities in the First Presbyterian Church of Sweetwater.

He stressed the need for membership growth, attendance, and participation in the activities of Rotary district-wide.
