Weather Expectations

In the Minneapolis area, October is a transition month from crisp autumn to potentially early winter conditions, with falling temperatures and decreasing daylight. On average, temperatures decline throughout the month, with average highs dropping from around 65°F at the start of October to 51°F by the end. The average low temperature drops from 47°F to 36°F during the month.
