Evanston Walking Tour-\$0

The entirety of this walking tour is cost-free. Wandering around Evanston is bound to bring something meaningful to your journey as you can travel from the Merrick Rose Garden, Evanston History Center, Dawes Park, and the Block Museum of Art at Northwestern University with ease.

Paul Harris Home & Memorial Tour-\$75

Connect with the history of Rotary International at the home of Paul and Jean Harris and the Memorial dedicated to Paul Harris and Silvester Schiele, the first president of the first club of Rotary – ROTARY/One in Chicago. The tour and history of the home and memorial will be led by a docent, and lunch will be provided at the home of Paul and Jean Harris. Transportation and lunch are included with this tour.

Lincoln Park Zoo-\$25

This includes payment for the travel to and from the destination. Join this group for beautifully landscaped grounds, walking paths, and picnic areas. From playful primates to graceful birds and fascinating reptiles, this zoo offers a captivating and educational experience.

Adler Planetarium- \$53

This includes payment for the travel to and from and the ticket to the museum and one sky show. Explore the wonders of the universe through the beautiful and immersive exhibits in this museum and watch one of the special sky shows in a theatre-like experience.

Art Institute of Chicago-\$57

This includes payment for the travel to and from the museum as well as your ticket to the museum. You can visit the world-renowned museum with exhibits from Caravaggio, Remedios Varo, and Camille Claudel.

River Boat Architecture Tour- \$74

This includes payment for the travel to and from the destination as well as your ticket for the 1.5-hour long boat cruise tour. This boat tour will show you all the wonders of the city of Chicago. This boat features unobstructed sightlines and guaranteed seating on our open-air upper decks and full-service cocktail and snack bars in their climate-controlled interior salons.

Big Bus Chicago Tour-\$74

This includes travel to the pickup destination and your ticket to this 2-hour bus tour. Marvel at the beauty of Chicago from the streets as you get to see places like Millennium Park, Willis Tower, and Navy Pier.
