The architecture of several ancient citadels with impressive heritage is sure to attract your attention. One example is the Rathaus or town hall. This grandiose neo-Renaissance building is deemed as the city's symbolic heart. Built in the late 1890s, Rathaus was heavily damaged during World War II. However, much of that is not evident any longer, thanks to the excellent restoration work carried out later.
