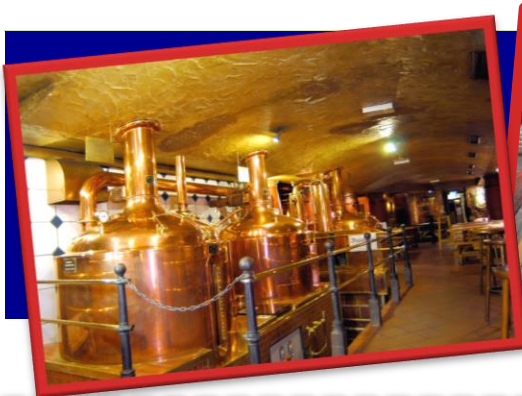

June 1, 2019 @ 6:00 pm

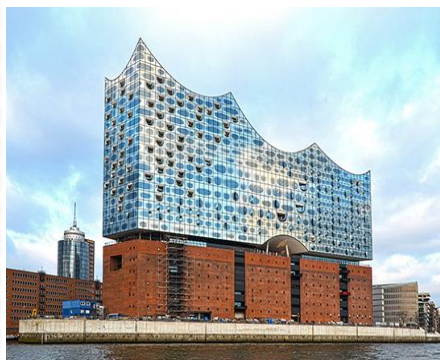
