Vehicle parking

AlburyCity's multi-level public carpark is open for use by the public.

It is a free carpark.

Access is from both Wilson and Olive Streets, the carpark has a total of 359 spaces – 116 at street level, 110 on level one and 118 on level two. There are 15 disabled car parking spaces and some reserved parking spaces.

Lift access is provided for the upper levels.

The Olive Street end includes 60 spaces at street level where there is unrestricted height. The rest of the park has a 2.3 metre height limit.

The park is open 24 hours a day, 7 days per week.

There is direct pedestrian access from the carpark, through to Swift St and Albury Entertainment Centre and takes approximately 3 minutes to walk.

Alternatively, street parking is available in Swift Street. Parking limits of one (1) or two (2) hours are in place between the hours of 8:30am and 6:00pm weekdays, and 8:30am and 12:30pm on Saturday.

Additional car parking located close to the Albury Entertainment Centre is outlined on the map over the page.


The SS&A Carpark located via entry off Wilson and Swift Streets has a total of 558 spaces – all at street level, and all free. It takes approximately 7 minutes to walk to the Albury Entertainment Centre.

The Myer Centrepoint Carpark located via entry off David and Swift Streets has a total of 652 parking spaces – a number of these are at street level while the majority are underground (these spaces are locked overnight). Parking limits of one (1) to three (3) hours are in place between the hours of 8:30am and 6:00pm weekdays, and 8:30am and 12:30pm on Saturday. It takes approximately 7 minutes to walk to the Albury Entertainment Centre.

The Volt Lane Carpark located via entry off Smollet Street has a total of 497 spaces – this is a multi-level carpark. Parking limits of one (1) to three (3) hours are in place between the hours of 8:30am and 6:00pm weekdays, and 8:30am and 12:30pm on Saturday. It takes approximately 6 minutes to walk to the Albury Entertainment Centre.

The Westend Plaza Carpark located via entry off Smollet and Kiewa Streets has a total of 601 spaces – this is a multi-level carpark. Parking limits of one (1) to three (3) hours are in place between the hours of 8:30am and 6:00pm weekdays, and 8:30am and 12:30pm on Saturday (these spaces are locked overnight). It takes approximately 8 minutes to walk to the Albury Entertainment Centre.

The Kiewa Street Carpark located via entry off Kiewa Street has a total of 365 spaces – this is a multi-level carpark, and all free. It takes approximately 10 minutes to walk to the Albury Entertainment Centre.
