Essay Contest Offers Area Youth \$1,000 Top Prize

One area high school student will be awarded the \$1,000 top prize in the Rotary District 7410 Essay Contest. In addition to the top award, there will be a second prize of \$500 and a third prize of \$250. All winners will be awarded their prizes at a club meeting, held in their honor.

Rotary District 7410 offers this Essay Contest as an incentive for young people to develop their skills of self-expression, and as evidence of a sincere desire to demonstrate service above self, which is Rotary's consistent motto.

All students in Junior and Senior years are eligible to participate.

The Essay theme for this year is:

"Create Hope in the World: How can Communities, Schools, Families, and or Friends support mental health with Caring, giving, and compassion?"
