Thailand Floods

Disasters don't stop for the Holiday period with major flooding in Southern Thailand. A new partner, Disaster Aid Thailand, sent out a request on the 3rd of January for help providing safe water for those affected. Two of our volunteers were soon on their way with four SkyHydrant Rapid Response Packs. These were installed in a four day period with two being close to Narathiwat and the other two in the region around Yala.

SkyHydrant GEM Rapid Response Pack in Zambia

One of our Rapid Response packs was recently installed in Zambia thanks to our partner Disaster Aid Europe.

This was a trial installation in response to a major cholera outbreak in that country.

The unit was installed in the Kenneth Kaunda School in Lusaka protecting 1,200 pupils.

Bhutan Review

Disaster Aid CEO Brian Ashworth has recently returned from Bhutan where he carried out a review of a sample of the 130 SkyHydrants installed since 2017.

All SkyHydrants visited were still working well.

At many of the schools Brian was told that water tests had revealed that the water from the SkyHydrants was of better quality than the bottled water sold locally.

An important part of the visit was making sure the operators were reminded how important they were in ensuring the long term sustainability of the SkyHydrants.

During the visit a further 2 SkyHydrants were installed.



Our partner Disaster Aid UK and Ireland have been active in helping those affected by the Morocco Earthquake that occurred in 2023.

This photograph shows a family that have been assisted with the timber home they are standing in front of. An important part of the Disaster Aid philosophy is about providing what people want not what we think they need. In this disaster long term shelter met those needs.

SkyHydrant Sponsorship

Safe Water for Every ChildWe are always looking for help with our " Projects.

It currently costs \$6,000 to sponsor an installation protecting a village or school.

This still is amazing value as the cost of safe water is still less than \$1 per person a year for 15 litres of clean bacteria free water daily.

Projects are currently running in Timor Leste, Bhutan and the Philippines.


