Col's Christmas Message

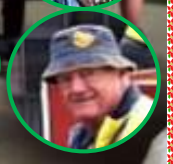
"2018 has been an exciting year for Donations in Kind with the closure of our facility at Durack and the move to 23 Mary Street Kingston which is now completed.
