Born into the arms of Rohingya parents from Myanmar, navigating the labyrinth of uncertainty in the UNHCR Rohingya camp in Ukhia, Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh Asma's entry into the world unfolded as a symphony of challenges and unexpected turns.

The urgency to reach the Medical Centre became a futile race against time, and Asma entered the world swiftly, unveiling bilateral complete cleft lip, alveolus, and cleft palate. The birth attendant, while noting the physical aspect as a 'deformity of the nose,' couldn't fathom the depth of the emotional journey that awaited.

Devastation and a chorus of varied comments enveloped Asma's mother, yet in the midst of this storm, she discovered an anchor in her unwavering faith.
