

ROTARY CLUBS IN DISTRICT 7430

Located in Southern Pennsylvania, starting just above Philadelphia near Springfield Flourtown and goes north about 128km to Slatington & Nazareth, taking in the Bethlehem and Allentown area's and is about 160km across from Reading in the west to Morrisville Yardley in the east just near the state line with New Jersey. Situated about 2 hours from New York City, 3 hours from Washington DC and about 1 hour to Philadelphia.

It is a very diverse district with some of the oldest historical sites in the US, along with cities, rolling hills and farmlands. The district contains a mixture of urban and agricultural areas which creates a diversity of lifestyles and vocations.

The exchange can include: - Visits to the historical city of Bethlehem, once the home of the Bethlehem Steel Corporation, Crayola Crayon, the Amish country in Lancaster County, Longwood Gardens, The Moravian area, Trips to New York and Philadelphia.

Because the district is so varied yet compact, they can drive from north to south in about 2 hours, allowing you to see a wide variety of people and places. You will stay in about 3 different places.
