MUNA 2022

Once again it is that time of the year to start planning to involve secondary school students in our Rotary District **Model United Nations Assembly**, giving them a hands-on experience of a UN style debate. **MUNA 2022 will be conducted at the Tweed Heads Civic Centre on Saturday, 30th April 2022 with registration commencing from 8.00am (NSW time). Programme to start at 9.00am (NSW time).**

Teams of 3 students generally nominated from years 11 and/or 12, meet under the auspices of District 9640, giving the students the opportunity to select a country, research its history, politics, economics, people, international alignment and make real life stances on world affairs. Having chosen a country, they then debate selected resolutions from that country's point of view.

Students do not incur any costs. A fee is paid by the nominating Rotary Club or the school for each team, as well as meeting the costs of all other arrangements. An accompanying adult, preferably a teacher, or a Rotarian or parent, is also invited to attend and support their team at no personal cost.

Students and teams are judged by a panel of judges. **There is a winning overall team selected to attend the National MUNA in Canberra in August 2022 to represent Rotary District 9640.** There will also be **an individual winner and runner-up selected.**

An Expression of Interest form is available on the above website to allow your school to indicate interest in this programme. Alternatively, you can download this form from the web address mentioned above. The Expression of Interest form should be mailed to me at the above address. A form is also available on this site that can be submitted directly to me by selecting the link "*MUNA 2021 Expression of Interest Form*".

Be aware that there is a limited number of places available, so early EOI and registration is important. To assist the MUNA Committee in its commitment to provide Duty of Care, the Registration Form will include additional Emergency Contact details and any dietary requirements.

A maximum of 28 teams will be accepted to allow all team members the opportunity to participate in the debates, but may vary due to Covid requirements. Each school can nominate up to three teams but the third team will be classified as a "reserve" team. This gives all schools an opportunity to have a team in MUNA 2022.

Each team will comprise 3 members only. No reserves are permissible unless there are extenuating circumstances and only with the prior approval of the District Chairman.

Please contact your nearest Rotary Club for sponsorship of the fee. Payment of the registration fee of \$350.00 per team would be required at the time of Registration, **but no later than the closing date of 31st March 2022**. A receipt will be issued separately.

Teacher, parents, friends and Rotarians are welcome to accompany their teams on the day. There will be a charge of \$20 per head for catering for those intending to join the students at morning and/or afternoon tea, and lunch, payable on the day. However, this charge will be waived for one accompanying adult for each team.

This letter is to allow you time to schedule MUNA into your 2022 school calendar and programme. I urge you to complete the Expression of Interest attached or from [https://www.rotary9640.org/page/model-united-nations-assembly-\(muna\)](https://www.rotary9640.org/page/model-united-nations-assembly-(muna)) and submit it **before the closing date of 28th February 2022, or sooner if possible**.
