What Impact Looks Like

Building Blocks

INPUT

The resources we invest in a project

Example:

Time, money, funding, materials

OUTPUT

The immediate results of activities that have taken place

Example:

Number of people trained, amount of materials delivered

OUTCOME

The intermediate results of our actions

Example:

Changes in behavior or attitude, adoption of systems or practices encouraged by project

IMPACT

The positive, longterm change resulting from our actions

Example:

Measurable improvements that would not have occurred otherwise
