

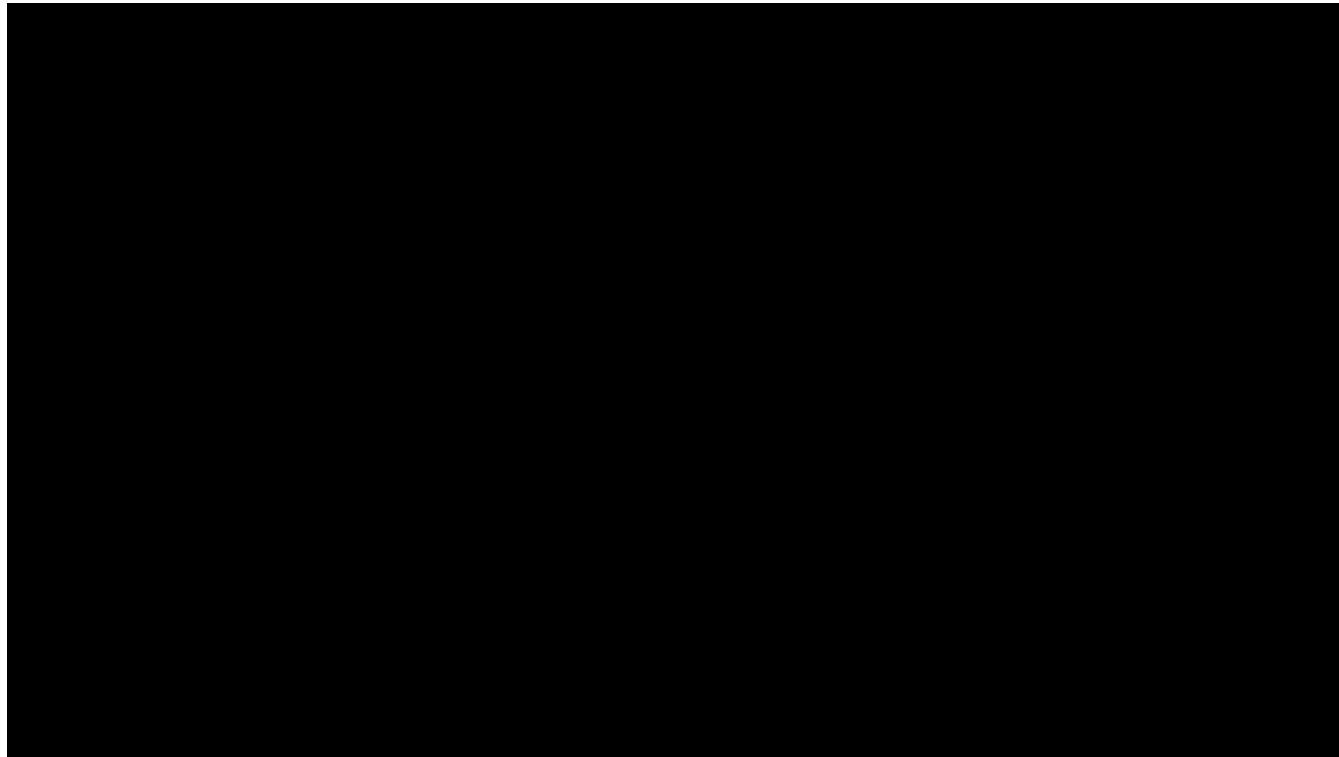

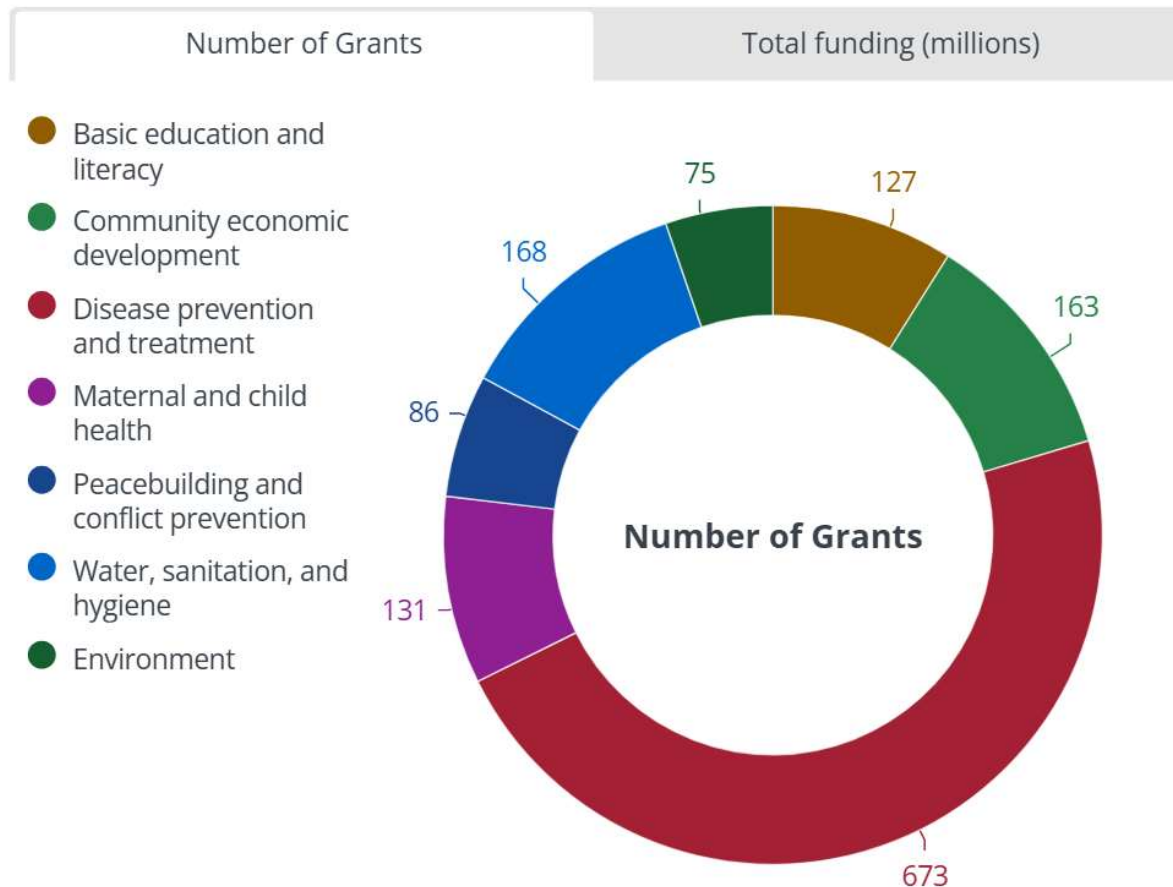

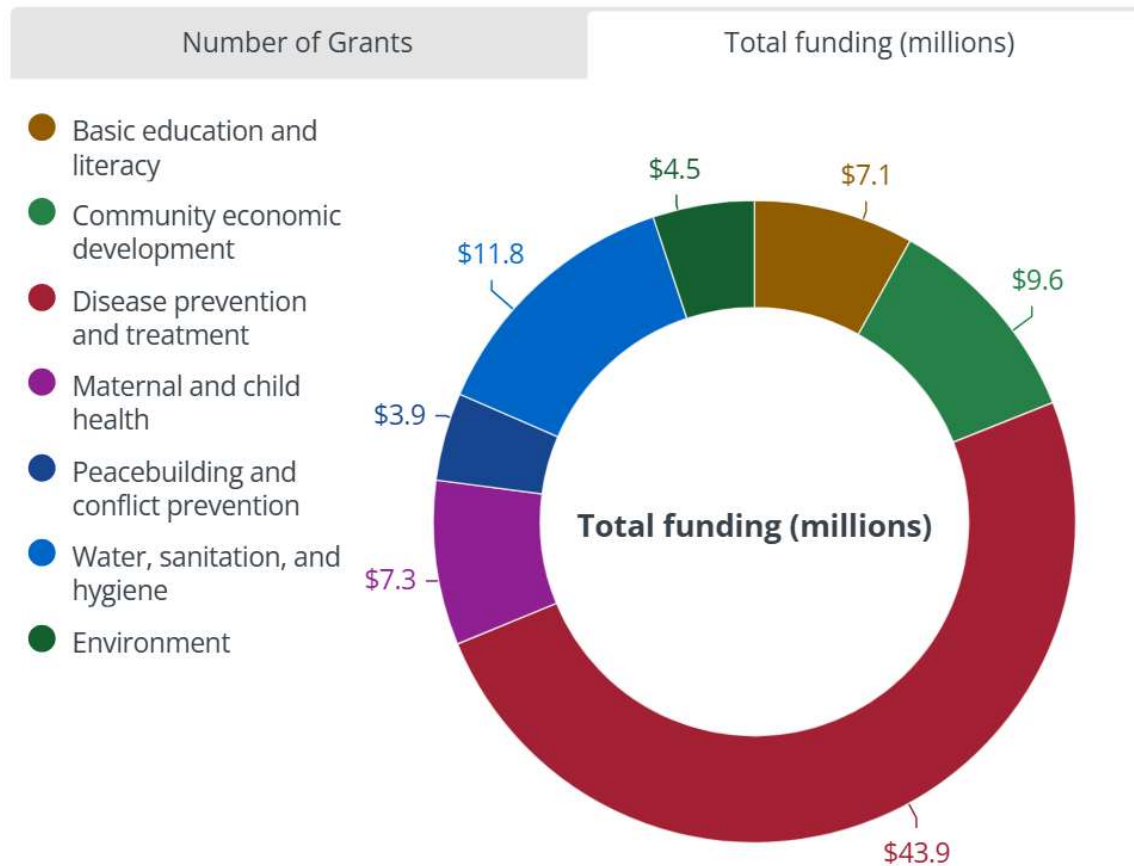

2024-25 Global Grants by Areas of Focus

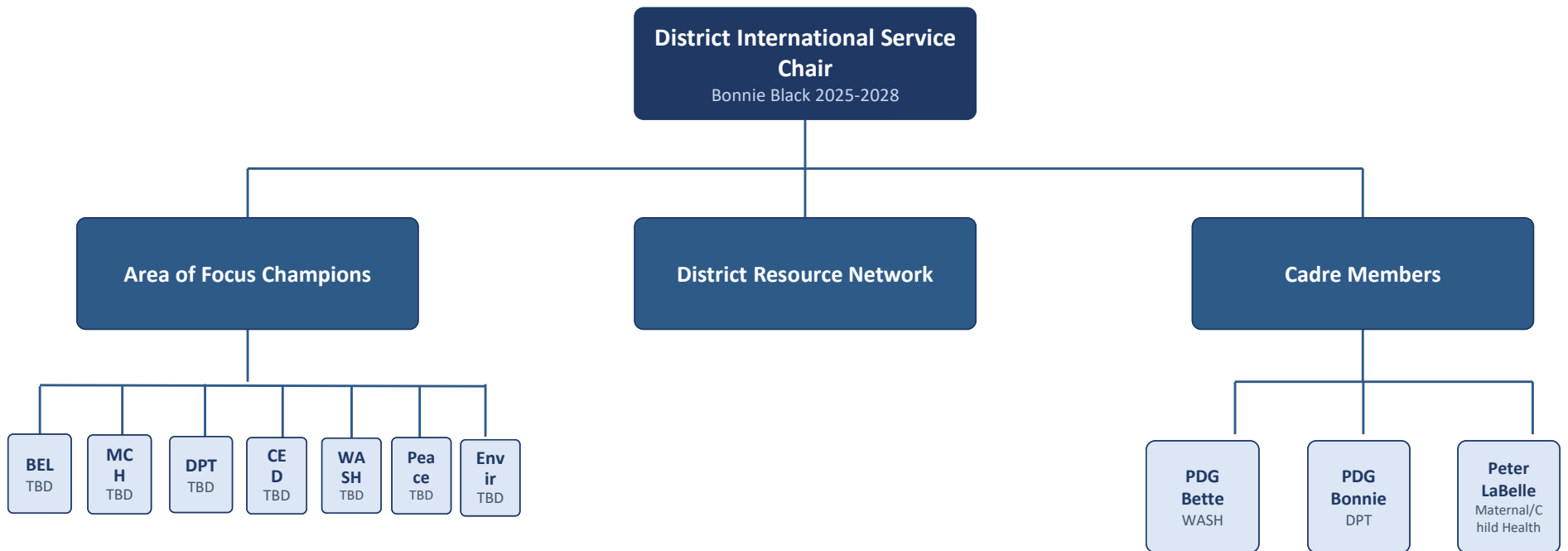

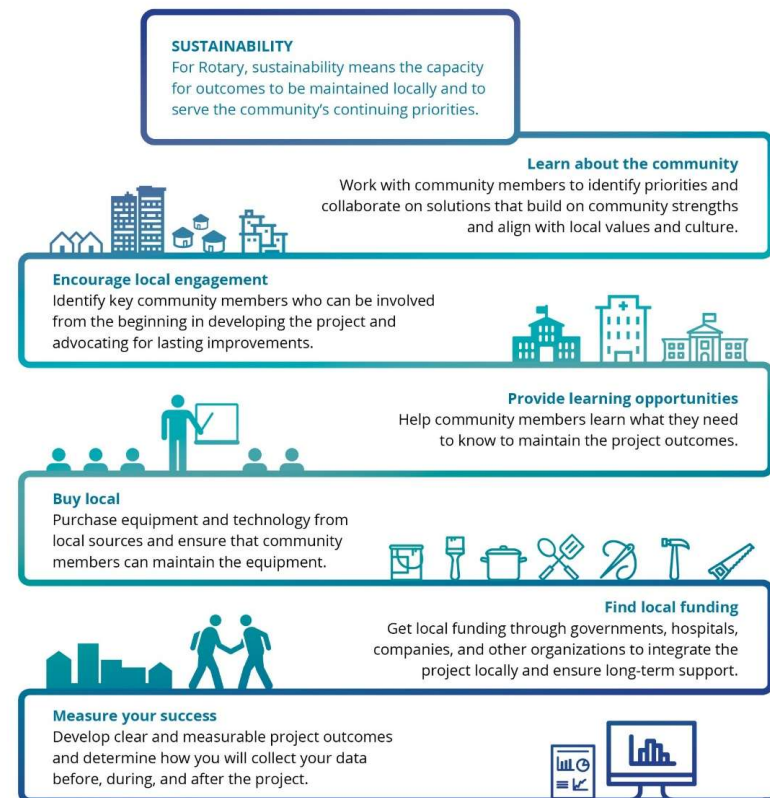
CONDUCTING A COMMUNITY ASSESSMENT

- Helps understand the community's issues and dynamics
- Guides decisions about service priorities
- Establishes valuable relationships
- Encourages community member participation
- Builds trust, a community commitment to a project, and sustainability



PLANNING FOR SUSTAINABILITY

- Ensures long-term impact
- Promotes community ownership
- Prevents dependency
- Makes the best use of Rotary's effort and funding

Understand whether the project is on track to meet its goals



Adjust the project plan, if needed

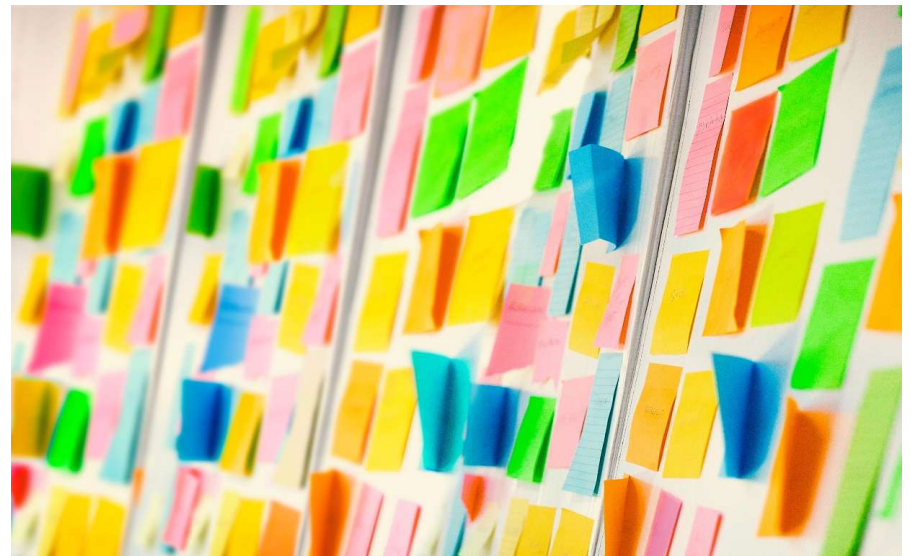
