ROTARY EVENTS AUTOMATICALLY COVERED at no additional premium

Weekly Meetings: Breakfasts, Lunches, Dinners

Annual Conferences

Leadership Training Sessions

Firesides (Where Rotarians attend other Rotarians with food and drink where they welcome new Rotarians and talk about Rotary)

Dinners with dancing, auctions, including themed dinners such as Oktoberfest, Crabfest, Bollywood, etc. with some liquor served. Revenue from alcohol is under 30% of the event.

Volunteering at local events <u>planned by others</u>, parades, beer gardens, fall fairs, craft fairs, music festivals, etc.

Volunteering at various programs, Pit Stop (feeding the homeless), Strong Start (feeding school kids), etc.

- Craft Fairs, Bake Sales, Book Sales, Salmon or chocolate sales for fundraising.

Beer, Whiskey or Wine Tastings with the following stipulations:

- Alcohol is served by brewery/winery
- Limit the number drink and serving size per person

Landscaping/Maintenance Projects, small construction projects, sheds, fences, park walkways, roadside clean up

Food drives, book drives, duck races

Safe Ride Home Programs

Terry Fox Fundraising runs – to get a certificate of insurance from Terry Fox Organization

Operation Red Nose - to follow all criteria provided by Operation Red Nose

Family walks, runs, or bike rides. No races or timed events

Non-Competitive and low risk "Sports": Golf Tournaments, Bonspiels, Fishing Derbies, 2 legged races, a game of soccer or baseball at a picnic.

Duck Races



Small Music Festivals: i.e. Music in the parks, piano or amateur concerts in churches, town halls, guest speaker events etc. under 5000 people.

Lotteries/Raffles/Shredding events: Booths set up in malls, farmers markets, parking lots, etc.

ROTARY EVENTS NOT AUTOMATICALLY COVERED - May require additional premium or separate policy

International Projects

Public Events fully planned and organized by Rotary:

- Canada Day Events
- Parades
- Fall Fairs
- Car Shows
- Ribfests

Competitive Sporting events:

- Marathons
- Bike Races
- Hockey tournaments
- Multi-day Festivals with Beer Gardens and attendance over 1000 people
- Rodeos

Events with:

- Bouncy Castles, unless Club and District are added to the rental company policy
- Fireworks/Pyrotechnics, unless club and district are added to fireworks display company insurance policy.
- Watercrafts over a certain size

ROTARY EVENTS NOT COVERED- Will require a separate policy

- Air Shows/Aerial Attractions
- Events with Amusement Rides
- Construction or Repair of Playground Equipment by Rotarians (NEW)
 - It is understood that Rotarians raise funds for playground equipment, but the installation and maintenance is undertaken by the community of school they are donated to.
- Bartending Service (where Rotarians are accepting income for bartending at non-rotary events)
