# Our new simple Rotary initiative is the "Feed A Farmer" Project!

This **simple project** does not involve any funds but a **simple gathering of long life food products** via Foodbank's request. This provides all of us the **simple opportunity to promote Rotary to our local community!!** 

By every Rotarian collecting food for Farmers we can also make Rotary more visible in our own neighborhood.

### **The Campaign**

The **Feed A Farmer** campaign was created by a Rotary Club in another District. The Rotarians then:

- Organised approval from their Coles to place a table outside the store;
- Handed shoppers a flyer highlighting nonperishable food items, advised by Foodbank;
- Shoppers deposited their food contribution on table as they departed;
- Rotarians collected heaps of food in two days over 8 hours;
- Rotarians took the food to their home for Foodbank to collect.
- **OR** use your Donation machine at your regular fundraising events
- Note: Call Foodbank before your collection. See Foodbank Info Foodbank will collect any food over 500 kilograms (or you deliver the goods directly to Foodbank)

#### What does this do for Rotary?

- Opportunity to assist our community to make a contribution
- ✓ Opportunity for Rotarians to promote this project and other projects of their Club
- Opportunity for a Rotary presence in your local area with your local community

#### What Do You Need To Do To Roll Out This Project?

- Prepare Club flyers, Supermarket handouts and table presentation
- Cluster Meeting: identify dates and supermarkets
- Contact Supermarket, each individual Club
- Foodbank will pick up 500kg or more (approximately 1200 cans) See email Emily Dawson in folder
