



## ROMAC SOUTHERN REGION CHAIR

Rotary Oceania Medical Aid for Children (ROMAC) requires a self-motivated Rotarian to fill the role of ROMAC Southern Region Chair.

The role of the Regional Chair is to co-ordinate patient and carer support together with promotion and fundraising within ROMAC's Southern Region, which is Victoria and Tasmania. The Regional Chair is a member of the ROMAC Operations Committee and attends regular meetings of that Committee. The position calls for the Regional Chair to assist the District Governor in selecting District Chairs with a view to maintaining viable ROMAC District Committees.

The successful applicant will be a Rotarian who has previously demonstrated excellent organisational, presentation and representational skills. A sound knowledge of Rotary structures and organisation would be advantageous as would a degree of computer literacy.

As noted ROMAC's Southern Region covers Victoria and Tasmania and, from a practical perspective, the successful candidate will reside within that Region.

Initially this is to fill a casual vacancy until the next ROMAC AGM.

After that, if so desired the position is for a term of four years which commences after the ROMAC AGM in Christchurch on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2019. However a shorter term of office would be available should it be necessary.
