Application for a Grant - Close November 30th 2020

- Ten grants of \$1,000 payable in two instalments are available for D9800 clubs in 2020
- Contact your target school early and ask them to identify a suitable scholarship recipient as soon as possible, but no later than November 15th 2020
- Explain the guidelines to the school, as set out in the *Rotary D9800-Scholarship Grant-Guidelines-Clubs*
- Club to submit the following forms with the application:
 - 1. District 9800 Foundation Scholarship Application Form 2021-2022.docx
- Scan the completed and signed form and email it to the Chair of the Humanitarian Grants
 Committee Richard Blakeman at:

- Submit the form no later than November 30th 2020
- Priority will be given to clubs that have not participated in the Scholarship Grant program in the
 past two years. After that, to applications will be considered in chronological order. First come first
 served.
- Payment of the first \$500 of the District Foundation contribution will be made upon approval of your application by the Humanitarian Grants Committee.

Grant Approved - Communication with the School

- Email the school using the suggested wording provided in the document *Rotary D9800-Scholarship Grant-Club Letter to School Template*
- Attach the following electronic files to your email:

 - 2. Rotary D9800-Scholarship Grant-Interim Report-2021.docx
 - 3. Rotary D9800-Scholarship Grant-Final Report-2022.docx
 - 4. Rotary D9800-Scholarship Grant-Acquittal Statement-2021-22,xlsx
- Diarise to ensure that the school is followed up in November 2021 for the Acquittal Report for the first grant year.
- Make the payment of the first instalment of \$1,000 for the Scholarship directly to the school in early December 2020, for the 2021 school year

Acquittal Process - End of First Year of the Grant

- Receive and verify the Acquittal Report from the school in November 2021. The Acquittal Report must contain the following properly completed documents:
 - 1. Rotary D9800-Scholarship Grant-Interim Report-2021.docx
 - 2. Rotary D9800-Scholarship Grant-Acquittal Statement-2021-22,xlsx
 - 3. Schools Receipt for \$1,000 first year grant payment
- Forward the documentation to the Chair of the Foundation Grants Stewardship Committee Katrina Flinn: <u>foundationstewardship@rotarydistrict9800.org.au</u> by November 30th, 2021
- Make the payment of the second instalment of \$1,000 for the 2022 school year directly to the school in early December 2021 after confirming that the same.student(s) is progressing to Year 12.

• The District Foundation Committee will process the payment of the second instalment of \$500 from your grant upon receipt of the Acquittal Report for the first year of the grant.

Acquittal Process - End of Second Year of the Grant

- Receive and verify the Acquittal Report from the school in November 2022. The Acquittal Report must contain the following properly completed documents:
 - 1. Rotary D9800-Scholarship Grant-Final Report-2022.docx
 - 2. Rotary D9800-Scholarship Grant-Acquittal Statement-2021-22,xlsx
 - 3. Schools Receipt for \$1,000 second year grant payment

Unused Funds

- Unused funds from the first year of the scholarship may be retained by the school and applied to
 expenses in the second year of the scholarship, provided the student beneficiary is progressing to Year
 12.
 - If the student elects not to proceed to Year 12, any unused funds are to be returned by the school to the club, and 50% of those funds must be returned to the District 9800 Foundation Grants Committee.
- Any unused funds from the \$2,000 scholarship at the end of the second year of the Scholarship, must be returned by the school to the club, and 50% of those unused funds must be returned by the club to the District 9800 Foundation Grants Committee:
