

Position Vacant D9800 Foundation Stewardship Chair



Stewardship is the cornerstone of The Rotary Foundation. It ensures the careful management of funds donated to the Foundation for its grant programs and educates Rotarians on proper and effective grant management.

The District Foundation Stewardship Chair plays an important role in helping to ensure the integrity of the Rotary Foundation Grant Management program in District 9800. As a member of the District Foundation Committee, the incumbent will also contribute to the development of policies and procedures aimed at encouraging clubs to engage with the Foundation when planning their service projects.

We now seek applications for this vital District position to commence on 1 July 2022. The role is a three-year appointment.

The successful applicant will work closely with District Grants Chair, Richard Blakeman, and District Foundation Chair, PDG Grant Hocking.

The duties of the Stewardship Chair include:

- Ensuring that clubs using District Grants are compliant with qualification and reporting requirements, and are acquitted in accordance with the terms and conditions of The Rotary Foundation
- Ensuring that District Grants are of good quality and have high impact.

- Educating Rotarians on the management of grant funds via the annual Grants Seminar and through personal communication.
- Maintaining a roster of clubs attending the Grants seminar.
- As a member of the Grants Committee, having an important role in the review and approval of District Grants.

The role requires attention to detail, reconciliation skills, persistence and the ability to communicate clearly. This is an excellent role for a Rotarian who has held a leadership role in their club and is looking to expand their Rotary experience and engage more broadly. The role can be successfully undertaken remotely, so regional Rotarians are encouraged to apply.

Full training in the role will be provided. If you would like to take on a useful District role and gain insight into how the Rotary Foundation, and its grants program, works this would be an ideal position for you.
