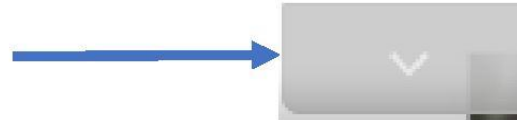

# ELECTRONIC RDU ARCHIVES (2016+)

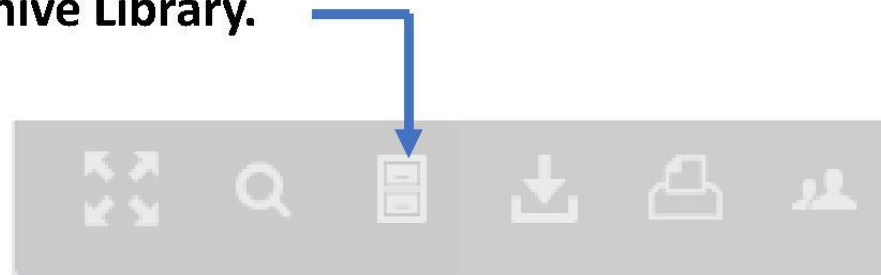
## To Search the RDU Archives Library:
