Description of the Project:

The Aetas are indigenous people living in different mountainous places in Luzon. They can be found in the provinces of Pampanga, Zambales, and Tarlac, to name a few. For several years, the Rotary Club of Batasan Hills had been giving the Aeta Communities food supplies, old clothes and school supplies for the children. However, this RY 2018-2018, we built a deep well for one Aeta community consisting of 206 families and 165 children at Brgy San Vicente, Bamban, Tarlac. This Aeta community is located at the top of a hill with a small school built for the children and the houses were also built by the non-governmental institutions. They have electricity but no source of water. The Aetas get their water from a spring or water streams and have to walk a long distance uphill.

The deep well was constructed for a total cost of Php 150,000.00 and the construction lasted for one month. It is more costly to build or construct deep wells at the top of the hill because more long pipes are needed. At its inauguration, the deep well was flowing with clean, potable water. The aetas were very appreciative and thankful for our gift of water. The Aeta community has a Sitio leader and officers, who are the elder Aetas. They promise us to take care of the deep well so that its life will be longer. We also tied up with a sister rotary club and the local

government so they can visit the place periodically to check if the deep-well is still in operation.

We had just given a deep-well, a source of water for one sitio of aeta community. Since the women Aetas will not be fetching water anymore, they will have more time for tilling the soil and plant root crops or they can engage themselves in some livelihood projects to earn extra income. There are more Aeta communities who are requesting for deep wells so they wouldn't be fetching unclean water from the spring or streams.

RC Batasan Hills is now applying for this global grant to be used for the construction of more deep-wells, not only for the barangays near or around San Vicente, Tarlac but also for the other sitios in the provinces of Pampanga and Zambales. We are asking for some help from the kind hearted and generous people of other RI Districts who have plenty of water for themselves. Let's give the "gift of source of water", in terms of deep-wells, which the Aetas will cherish in their lives. Correspondingly, if they can have safe, potable water from deep wells, their lives and their children's lives will be improved and good sanitation will follow. Then we can make their lives better and only then, can we truly say to the whole world that we are able to make a difference.

SUSTAINABILITY:

The elders and officers of the Aeta community promise to look after the deep-well to ensure that the structure is still viable and will be producing clean, safe water for them.

The project is not income generating per se, but since women Aetas will not be fetching water anymore for their families, they can devote their time to planting crops or do some livelihood projects like weaving or sewing, or making baskets for some additional income.

FOR ONE (1) MANUAL DEEP WELL PUMP FINISH BORE AND DRILL

- 120 Feet Deep Hole Finish
- 60 Feet Deep Hole for Casing Pipe
- Total 180 Feet Deep Hole
