Despite improvements in immunisation rates, the poorest and hardest to reach children are being left behind.

- Pneumonia and diarrhoea remain the leading killers of children.
- In countries like Kiribati, nearly 1 in 18 children die before their fifth birthday.



- Weak health systems and limited capacity
- Complex environmental challenges
- Access is difficult





Immunisation rates across the Pacific are poor



Project overview

Introduce 3 new vaccinations:

- Rotavirus
- Pneumococcal disease
- Cervical cancer (HPV)
 Across 9 Pacific Island
 Countries.

100,000 children and adolescent girls immunized.

By working closely with each country's Government, the program will be sustainable, so generations of children and adolescent girls will be supported.




*Support in Kiribati for rotavirus vaccination only initially

Program activities

Vaccinations Rotavirus (to prevent rotavirus), PCV - Pneumococcal Conjugate (to prevent pneumococca disease), HPV - Human Papilloma Virus (to prevent forms of cervical cancer)			
Timeframe	Four year program, 2018 - 2021		
Beneficiaries	Approximately 70,000 children (rotavirus and PCV vaccinations) and 30,000 adolescent girls (HPV vaccination)
