

Programme

RYLA provides a varied programme that includes seminars, activities and group discussions. A wide range of topics and presenters is an exciting feature, as well as high quality presentations relevant to leadership development. The programme topics will be based on the following themes:

Supervision

What is RYLA?

Run successfully for over 20 years, RYLA is a Rotary “New Generations” service project intended to develop leadership skills among young adults. It comprises a 6 day live-in opportunity to participate in discussions, seminars, activities and interactions which for many are “life changing”. It is offered to young people from all walks of life who have the potential to make a difference within their communities.

RYLA's Success

More than 25,000 young people graduate from RYLA courses, camps and seminars each year in countries around the world. It provides an environment in which young people develop their leadership, team-work and communication skills. Many RYLA graduates refer to the RYLA experience as “the week that changed my life”. RYLA helps participants understand the aspects of personal leadership, community and business. For young people RYLA offers a unique opportunity to develop self confidence and a wide range of personal skills such as planning, personal organisation and public speaking. For business organisations RYLA offers a unique opportunity to recognise and develop the leadership potential they see in their 20-29 year old employees. For parents RYLA offers an opportunity to actively develop that leadership potential you see in your young adult sons and daughters.

The RYLA mission

Create a leadership experience combining theory with experiential learning situations to promote the skills and behaviours required of leaders by utilising outstanding facilitators and inspirational leaders to share knowledge and modern leadership practice with delegates.

Objectives

- To bring together young people aged 20 to 28, who have shown leadership qualities
- To provide information, instruction and experience on a wide range of subjects of interest and benefit to the delegates, utilising appropriate industry and community leaders and experts as presenters.
- To equip, instruct and encourage promising young people from differing cultures and backgrounds, to better serve their communities and countries.
- To encourage leadership of young people by young people.
- To recognise young people who are providing service to their communities.
- To provide delegates with an experience they will not forget and that will benefit them well into the future.
- To provide an environment for young leaders to build relationships that develop into lifetime friendships and networks.
