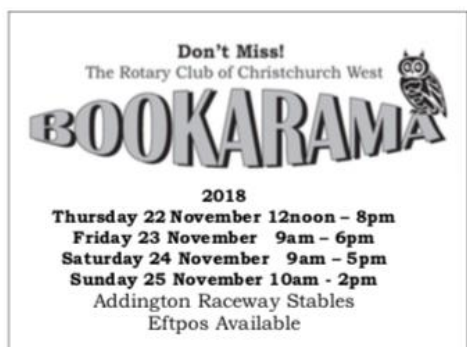
**Young Totara Award Nominees.** Doug asked members to contact him with suggestions for people for the Young Totara Award.
