## John Rickard - District Foundation Chair

The foundation is where the rubber hits the road, it is means of collecting money from people who want to do good in the world and distributing this. It's a different organisation to Rotary International, they do share some board members however they are completely separate entities.

There are three ways that the Rotary Foundation get money, club and personal contributions, endowment or bequest and then the Polio Fund.

\$1,000,000.00 is received per annum and the interest is used to run the foundation.

You can become a Rotary Foundation Centurion by contributing \$100.00 each year directly to the foundation or alternatively donating \$1,000.00 USD

Polio money goes directly to Polio, it is used for this and nothing else. The Annual fund is invested for 3 years and the money is then distributed, 50% top district designated funds (for district grants) and the remaining 50% to the world funds.

The World Fund is Strategic Partnerships e.g. Mercy Ships, World Health Organisation, Shelter Box etc. Funds from here are also distributed into Peace fellowships to train people from their own country to help manage conflict. Vocational training is another way this money is used.

If you are looking to make an application for a grant:

1. Give generously to the foundations
2. Start planning early
3. Be bold and innovative
4. Involve your fellow Rotarians
5. Have all your funding streams in line before you apply

The Rotary Foundation has 4 stars, is rated one of the best charitable organisations with one of the lowest administration costs in the world. Next time you are thinking of donating to a charity maybe you could consider the Rotary Foundation. Huge thanks to John for sharing his spectacular knowledge.


