Rachael a very talented young woman grew up in Darfield and shared with us her background and leadership journey to date. Not only was she Head Girl at Darfield High School, but she was also the student representative on the Board of Trustees and the PTA. She studied for her degree at Lincoln University, taking up farm work in the weekends. Her love of the outdoors led her to get involved in volunteering and become the Youth Advisor for Lincoln District Community Care. At Lincoln University she was chosen to be part of the Future Leaders Programme participating in this for 3 years. She is currently working in Tauranga as a planner.



Prior to going to RYLA, she had been involved with Lincoln Rotary club and so was keen to take up the opportunity. She provided us with an overview of each day, as well as the stand outs for her. The line up of speakers were impressive, but for Rachael it was the message Michelle Sharp, CEO of UNICEF that spoke to her the most of "knowing your purpose and being proud of yourself in your everyday life". Other moments were Richard Smith providing training in leadership approaches, learning about a business mindset of leadership and the servant leadership style. The events included a quiz night, attending a Rotary club meeting, yoga and high ropes challenges and the formal dinner.

As is tradition, each group developed a potential Rotary project and her group came up with the idea of running Rotary skills workshops where people could share employment skills and hobbies with young people.

Rachael said that the experience really got her brain thinking about the skills that she already has and how keen she is to be involved in leadership roles in the future.
