There were also matters of legal advice at which point Citizen Advice Bureau can offer assistance on where to seek assistance without given aid. Other issues included issues around consumer guarantees, including whether or not extended warranties are worth the additional money.

On the lighter side we also heard about how one of our own members who volunteers for one of the Christchurch branches had to deal with an issues of a rooster up a neighbours tree. Not an occurrence you would expect to occur on a shift when dealing with local citizens issues and concerns.
