

Rotary Club Assembly Wednesday 28 July 2021

On Wednesday the Annual AGM was held, along with the Club Assembly. The anticipation arose as we arrived to find 5 blue dots for every person laid out on our table. On one wall, lists of activities the club have been involved in were written out on posters, President Liz asked us over the night to place a blue dot next to the activities we individually would like the club to be involved in over the coming year. One of President Liz's aims this year is for our club to achieve a Rotary Citation and so club members in groups set targets, on what they think is achievable in a number of categories.

The 2021 AGM was led by Alan McKinnon, our Treasurer who presented the accounts for the year. Donations given by the club over the year totalled \$28, 899.58, and the Charitable Trust ended the year with a balance of \$6715.31. Accounts were adopted by club members, subject to independent review. The club voted and agreed on an increase of annual subscription to \$250.00.

A huge vote of thanks to Alan McKinnon for the large amount of work he has undertaken over the past year for the club. Notification of a review of our charitable trust constitution to be led by David Conroy was given.




The meeting moved onto the Assembly. Topics covered included:

Westport Flood Relief - Update

Westport Rotary has accepted the challenge to coordinate the distribution of donated goods, including bedding and linen.

A team from Greymouth Rotary were in Westport on Friday to assist Westport Rotary to set up a donated goods hub, sort through the mountain of donated 'stuff' and get ready for the hub to open on Monday. Three local like-minded groups will share a shop space.

President Peter Campbell has set up a relief fund in the Westport Club, to distribute funds to those in need. There are many who will be underinsured or carry no insurance, and this is an area where we can help. Donations of over \$6000 has been donated to date from clubs and individuals.

Approximately 100 families will be out of their homes for up to a year, or in some cases, may have to find alternative accommodation. Sadly, it was one of the older, poorer areas of town that that bore the brunt of the flooding, with many homes underinsured.

When the homes are repaired a call will be made for furniture, bedding and household goods. That may be some months away.

Foodbank Canterbury made a second delivery of food staples and cleaning supplies yesterday. The Richmond Rotary club is coordinating a team of skilled volunteers who will be available next month to help with reinstatement and repairs of houses that didn't have adequate insurance.


