John Sunckell—Future Land and Water Planning

John Sunckell our speaker this evening is a third generation dairy farmer from Leeston and Paramedic. John also serves as a Councillor at Environment Canterbury (ECan) and will be standing for re-election for one of the two Mid Canterbury seats on ECan in this year's election. Portfolios John looks after include Hazards, Risk and Resilience, Freshwater Management, Air Quality and Regional Leadership.

There have been significant improvements in public health following the clean air programme in Canterbury. Air quality in Canterbury is continually improving, thanks to the efforts of thousands of people to burn smoke-free and upgrade to ultra low emission technology.

ECan has recently completed a \$40,000,000 project to rebuild and buffer the stop banks of the Waimakariri River. This project finished early and under budget protecting recreation activities that operate beside the river for all of us to enjoy.

The extent of ECan's reach is significant from helping manage hazards, risk and effects of activity in our environment. Climate change and how that impacts us all including how the Council is able to manage our carbon footprint as an organisation.

John is interested in having conversations about how we can affect change, having opportunities with technology to help impact climate change and equipping industry with tools to enable achieving both climate and economic goals.

The Canterbury water management strategy has been in place for the last 10 years and covers an extensive area. There is significant consultation with community and has been a huge success. ECan has identified good practice in farming and shared results with the industry to ensure that our environment and waterways are protected for the benefit of everyone.

A huge thanks to John for being our speaker and the amazing insight he has given us into the role and responsibility of ECan and his service in our community. John's extensive knowledge in to several subject areas has been enlightening.
