Experience / Skills	International service project experience is helpful, along with a willingness to mentor, share practical knowledge, and connect clubs with useful resources.
Training / Support	District guidance, experienced international service mentors, Rotary resources, and relevant Rotary Learning Center courses are available to support committee members.
