

Clubs in our district have rallied behind sponsoring young people on the two special 7-day Youth Sailing Challenges, firstly the voyage to Melbourne, departing Adelaide on Friday 19th May, and secondly, the return voyage to Adelaide, departing Melbourne on 4th June.

We should be proud since in spite of the high cost of \$1900 (including extra days, student airfares and extra interstate charges for the One and All) a record number of 24 students have been sponsored by 9510 clubs, or in some instances pairs of clubs. In addition, the newly formed Rotary Youth Challenge Sail Committee in Victoria, are doing very well in attracting Victorian Rotary clubs to sponsor and select suitable for students for these two voyages ...so we are close to full capacity.

The huge benefits young people gain from these voyages has attracted further Commercial Sponsors including now the Baxter Grimshaw Foundation. These commercial sponsors have enabled a number of disadvantaged young people to participate.




SCIENCE AND ENGINEERING CHALLENGE
