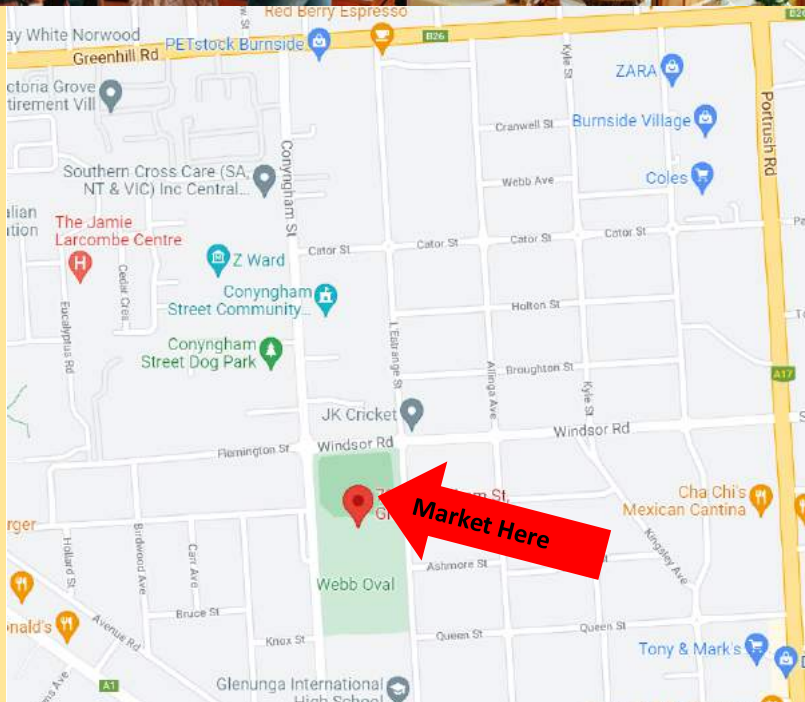

On the last Friday of the month we have an "Away Walk" and meet in another suburb. Phone Russell on 0417672559 for details.



Despite the challenges of the Covid-19 pandemic during which it has not been possible to facilitate medical teams travelling to the Asia Pacific to give high quality surgical services and training to those who could not otherwise afford or access these, Interplast has continued to fulfil its vision to provide people in developing countries across the Asia Pacific region timely access to high quality surgical, medical and allied health services... 37 LIVE-STREAM WEBINARS in 2020-2021, targeting nurses, allied health professionals, surgeons and anaesthetists, reaching 2,464 participants. These webinars were viewed in all 17 of our existing partner countries – Bangladesh, Bhutan, Mongolia, Philippines, Fiji, Myanmar, Samoa, Vanuatu, Tonga, Vietnam, Laos, Sri Lanka, Nepal, Kiribati, Indonesia, Solomon Islands, Papua New Guinea, as well as 21 additional countries. The webinars are also available on demand.



Facilitation of formal **MENTOR/MENTEE RELATIONSHIPS** between Australian and New Zealand medical volunteers and overseas partner surgeons and other health professionals.
