

Cold Plunge for Those in Need


The Rotary Club of Glenelg has conducted its Cold Plunge for Those in Need for over 5 years.





Experienced Quiz Master Rotarian Brian Wheatley from the Rotary Club of Regency Park will provide a fun evening with support from his club.



37 LIVE-STREAM WEBINARS in 2020-2021, targeting nurses, allied health professionals, surgeons and anaesthetists, reaching 2,464 participants. These webinars were viewed in all 17 of our existing partner countries – Bangladesh, Bhutan, Mongolia, Philippines, Fiji, Myanmar, Samoa, Vanuatu, Tonga, Vietnam, Laos, Sri Lanka, Nepal, Kiribati, Indonesia, Solomon Islands, Papua New Guinea, as well as <u>21</u> additional countries.
