This is a 3-day residential program and participants will need to attend the whole of the program.

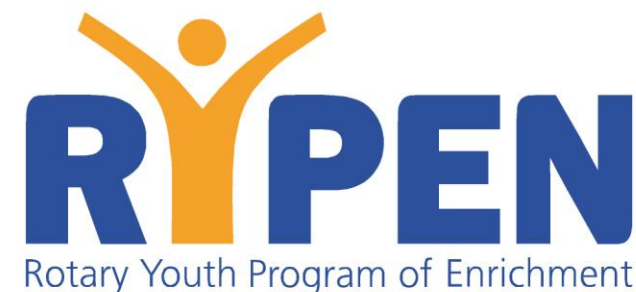

What is RYPEN

The Rotary Youth Program of Enrichment is a 3 day residential program for young people aged 14 to 17 years old, held annually at the Nunyara Conference Centre, Belair.

RYPEN aims to provide opportunities for young people to develop important life-skills, and to assist them to progress their communication and leadership skills through a range of formal and informal activities.

Activities

Participants take part in a range of activities including:

- Ice-breakers
- Discussion forums
- Comedy skits
- Workshops
- Small group work
- Physical challenges

Personal Development

Experienced young facilitators will support and encourage participants in the program to develop their:

- Public speaking skills
- Teamwork
- Self-care and resilience
- Problem-solving skills
- Communication Skills
- Goal setting

RYPEN's focus is on assisting young people to become active and valuable members of society, and to develop their abilities as potential leaders.

Participants are given the opportunity to develop their leadership, communication and problem-solving skills, practicing new behaviours, forging life-long friends and challenging their personal belief systems and values.

RYPEN costs \$425, but most participants will attend at no cost, fully sponsored by Rotary Clubs within our district. Some Rotary Clubs may request a \$50 holding deposit which is fully refundable when the applicant attends RYPEN.

Once registered, applicants will be contacted directly by their sponsoring Rotary Club, the club may ask to interview the applicant.

All leaders on the program have WWC checks and have been vetted for suitability in line with the Rotary Child Protection Policy.
